## FOCUS by Fr Bill Senn

*"... we hear them preaching in our own language about the marvels of God!"* Acts 2:11

These words, friends, from our 1<sup>st</sup> Reading this Sunday, for the Solemnity of Pentecost! **ALLELUIA!!** We can hear the *excitement* in the words ... **we hear them preaching in our own language ...** about what exactly?? ... **about the marvels of God!!**

Are we **excited** by the wonders God accomplishes in our lives? Am I simply **bursting** with joy each time I encounter and experience **Christ the Risen Lord** in the Eucharist? And then, does my joy burst forth into my life thereafter?? Am I animated and empowered to **GO FORTH** from the Mass to proclaim and share the **GOOD NEWS** of God's Love??
